ZESS has started a new shop program featuring wood-working, carving, and wood-burning. This program is designed to support students who are thinking of entering the trades. Students learn basic shop safety, use hand tools, and are encouraged to build items for personal use. At this time two ceremonial cedar paddles, one spruce table, and a set of spruce shelves are under construction. Students learn Math and English skills through hands on activity.

ZESS continues the Fish Hatchery project this year in partnership with the Ehattesaht Band. The Alcove stream restoration is also online to be continued. The recycling and worm composting projects have already restarted. Last year this project enabled the grade 3-6 class to travel to Vancouver after winning the Green Games Environmental Action Award, sponsored in part by Science World.

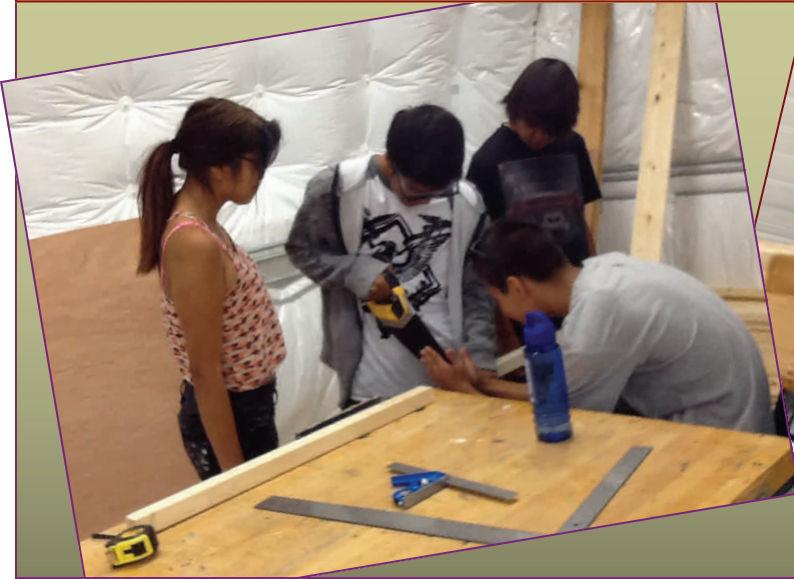
