The Nootka Sound Outdoor Program is excited to offer our grade 10-12 students the opportunity to complete industry-relevant and valuable online certifications and earn credits toward graduation! NSOP will cover registration fees!

Food Safe

A food handling, sanitation and work safety course designed for food service establishment operators and front-line food service workers such as cooks, servers, bussers, dishwashers, and deli workers. The course covers important food safety and worker safety information including foodborne illness, receiving and storing food, preparing food, serving food, cleaning and sanitizing.

Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC)

A Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC), more commonly known by Canada's boating community as a 'boating license', is a federal competency card. You must obtain and carry your PCOC in order to legally operate any powerboat or motorized boat in Canada.

WHMIS 2015 for Workers

This course familiarizes you with the WHMIS 2015 system and how it is used in workplaces. Learning about WHMIS 2015 is part of the knowledge that you need to protect yourself and your co-workers from hazardous products.

SuperHost® Foundations of Service Quality

SuperHost® Foundations of Service Quality™ is a comprehensive, practical introduction to the principles of providing a quality service experience. This course is ideal for people who are either entering the workforce for the first time or after a significant break, or are fairly new at working in a front-line, customer-facing role.

CORE Hunter Education

Designed by experienced CORE instructors, this online course covers the theoretical portion of the BC CORE hunter education program. It combines informative slides and relevant quizzes to help prepare you to take the CORE hunter education course or challenge the test.

Psychological First Aid – Self-Care & Caring for Others

This online course assists learners in developing a personal understanding of the effects of stress, loss, trauma and grief, with emphasis on self-care and personal protection. Learners will be introduced to the Red Cross Look, Listen, Link, Live model and will learn how to cope with the effects of various types of stress.

Maritime Radio Restricted Operator Certificate (Maritime)

The Maritime Radio course teaches emergency radio procedures and everyday operating techniques. Learn all about the uses of marine radios, choice of frequencies, operation, phonetic alphabet, procedural words and phrases, as well as Digital Selective Calling and the Global Maritime Distress and Safety System, (DSC/GMDSS).

1 certification = 1 course credit
