



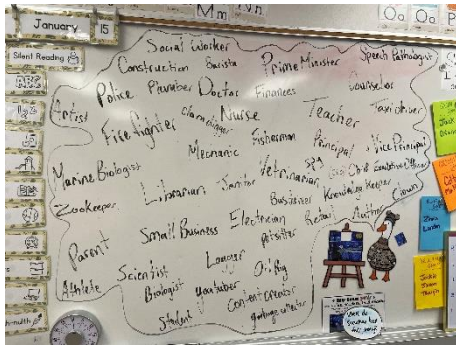

We are also enjoying listening to *The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe* - by C.S. Lewis, as a class novel over snack time.

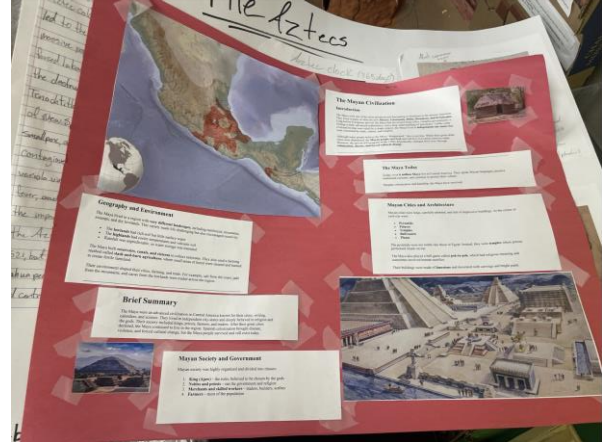
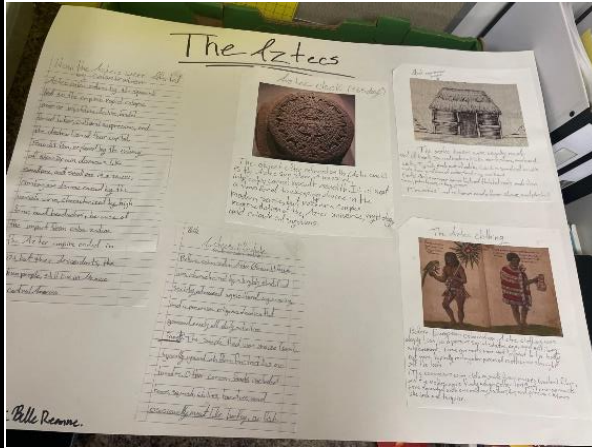
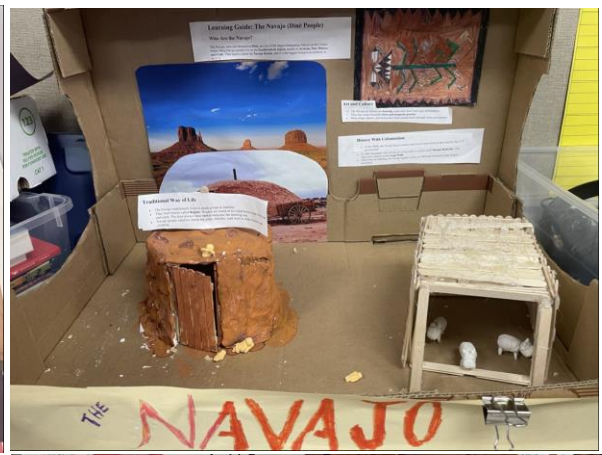
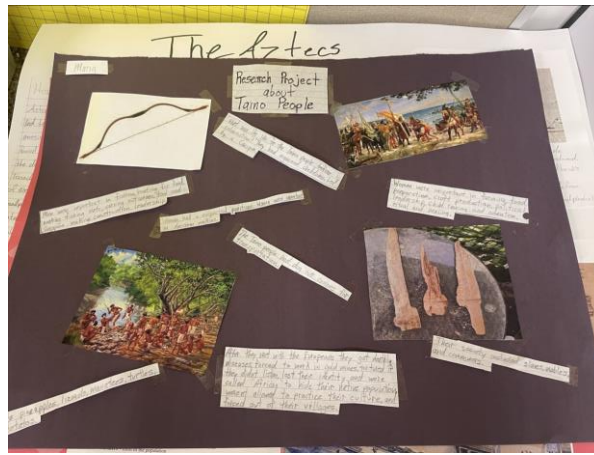
We have also begun using dictionaries, both individual paper copies and published books, to help us write more independently. This tool has been very empowering for many students, with our vocabularies growing quickly

What is happening in class?

Junior (5-7): Mr. Vanden Ham - A new year has brought lots of fresh learning to our classroom! In mathematics, students are working on **division** and continuing to explore the **volume of shapes**, strengthening both their computation and spatial reasoning skills. In language arts, we are beginning an exciting **cookbook writing project**, where students will practice procedural writing and clear instructions. In art, students have started **linocut printmaking**, learning about carving, pattern, and print techniques. We have also attached a photo from class that perfectly captures how we were all feeling during the recent **power outage**—a tired but resilient group! It's been great to see students jump back into learning with enthusiasm and creativity after the break.



Senior (8-10): Mr. Romyn - Our seniors class has wrapped up our unit on the impacts of colonization with research projects and have begun to learn about how ideologies led to World War I.



With winter sickness, family and community activities before Christmas break, and the power outages attendance is down from previous months. We continue to track in 20 day challenges. Our current challenge goes until January 22. Our attendance as a school for this period is 74% down about 10% from previous challenges. It is similar to this same time period last year. Hopefully, most of the sickness has left the community, our power is stable, and attendance is up for our next challenge. 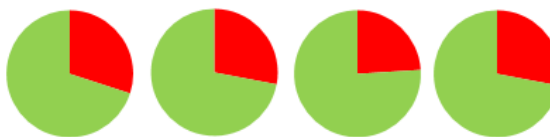
