Distant Alaskan Tsunami Community Evacuation Exercise

When: Wednesday, April 15th, from 2 - 3:30pm

How do I participate?

pm 2:00

- You'll receive an **Alertable notification** indicating that an incoming distant tsunami generated in Alaska will arrive in 3.5 hours and be 4-meters tall.
- The **tsunami sirens** will sound.

pm 2:05

- **Evacuate on foot or bicycle to the Ehatís Tsunami Muster Site** adjacent to the Zeballos FSR (with the 3 seacans).

For the purpose of the exercise, **please walk or bike** to minimize congestion. Please bring your **vehicle only if absolutely required.**

- When you reach the Ehatís Tsunami Muster Point you'll be treated to a **burger or hot dog**. Then mingle for as little or as long as you'd like and **learn about disaster preparedness**. You'll be entered to **win a one of two household emergency kits**.

pm 3:30

- **Event ends.**



Note:

In a real tsunami warning scenario, we advise you to evacuate to the east side of Vancouver Island. Only go to the Zeballos or Ehatís Tsunami Muster Sites on the FSR to find a ride or reunite with loved ones before evacuating.
